EAA Chapter 80 Meeting Minutes

April 2017

The chapter meeting was held on April 10th at Iowa Western Community College (IWCC), Council Bluffs Airport aviation campus. The meeting was called to order at 7 PM by President Chris Halfman. Pizza (at \$5 per person) was provided during the meeting.

Meeting Minutes: The March 2017 meeting minutes were approved as published in the newsletter.

Treasurer's Report: The April treasurer's report was approved as published.

Membership: Bob Condrey reported that the dues payments have slowed down. He will be sending out emails to those still needing to pay.

Tech Counselor: Mike Howard had nothing to report.

Young Eagles: Jim Beyer thanked those who helped fly the 35 Young Eagles last weekend. The next YE weekend is May 6th at Millard. Those interested in handing out the YE flight date information cards can get them in the Chapter80 closet at Millard airport for distribution at local churches, restaurants, or other posting places.

Tools: Jerry Ronk reported that all tools are in the hangar. Darryl Jackson donated a cable tension gauge to the chapter.

Builder Reports: Nothing to report.

Builders Meeting: Still awaiting warmer weather. May schedule a builders meeting to fix the chapter flatbed trailer one Saturday.

Fly-outs: Mike Howard recently attended the Ames lowa pancake breakfast. No other fly-outs scheduled so far. Norfolk's Barnstormers restaurant is re-opening soon.

Social Coordinator: Nothing to report.

Old Business:

- Mike Howard presented a \$1,000 EAA Chapter 80 scholarship to Ethan Memming, with IWCC representatives Gene Jedicka and Dylan Driscoll attending. Ethan was very appreciative of the scholarship.
- 2) Since a cable tension meter was donated, there is no need to purchase one.

- 3) Trailer mods to the axle and decking still planned, no change from last month.
- 4) The Tri-Motor is on for Jun 22-26. Still need volunteers. Mike Howard will send out an email. A three man crew is needed for Thursday afternoon, then a four man crew each day after. Let Mike know if you can help.
- 5) Jim Beyer updated the investigation into a 501(c)3 versus a 501(c)7. Jim will be sending out an email to the membership with general and specific information on what it may take to create the 501(c)3. Changes will be required of the chapter by-laws on file with the state of Nebraska, money required by the IRS, a change to the chapter treasurer book keeping, etc.. With this information provided to the membership, Jim would like a motion at next month's meeting for the members to vote on this proposal.

New Business:

- Paige Hoffart asked about the interest to purchase a Lycoming front seal installation tool for ~\$90 from Aircraft Tool Supply. Discussed but decided that this tool would not work on a Continental engine. Will bring picture of one to the next meeting to seek interest.
- 2) Chris Halfman advised the group of the intent to utilize Square (credit card by phone) as an alternative for membership and other payments. A credit card reader will be available for Android and Apple phones. Fees are 2-1/2 to 3-1/2% on \$25 membership dues. After receiving an email, members will be able to go on-line with Squareup.com via a link and make payment directly on the web using a credit card. For those utilizing this payment method, a dues increase of \$1 may be proposed to cover the fees.

Announcements:

- Bob Condrey asked that Chapter 80 consider officially sponsoring the Aviation Nation RV12 build project. There would be no financial commitment. Chris will look into how the chapter could potentially do this and report back next month.
- 2) The Crete Fly-in breakfast, 3rd Saturday of the month, is coming up.
- LandsEnd offers embroidery with our Chapter 80 logo for those interested. Chris showed off the catalog he received with our chapter logo on the cover. Making a purchase, or simply registering on their

website, can lead to future sales and discounts from LandsEnd.

Presentation: Gene Jedicka (Aviation Department chairman / instructor) and Dylan Driscoll (instructor) from IWCC provided information on the aviation maintenance curriculum, facilities and students. The first aviation maintenance technician class graduated from IWCC in 1969. Last year there were 14 mechanics that graduated. All were placed in jobs, a few at the airlines, but all outside the local area. Companies that have shown an interest in IWCC include: Duncan Aviation, Textron Aviation, Elliott Aviation, and Endeavor Air.

Night courses are being considered, but it may be several years before it could be implemented.

The IWCC Aviation Program is trying to partner up with the Burke High School Aviation Academy to assist during their building expansion. The expansion includes installing a flight simulator and they expect to also add a maintenance training curriculum. This course work could potentially earn the students college credit while in high school.

A tour of the facilities included their tech manual / library room, multiple classrooms, engine maintenance lab, fabrication lab, and aircraft hangar. It was mentioned that an avionics curriculum is not part of this program. They are happy to accept aircraft and or parts for donations to the school.
