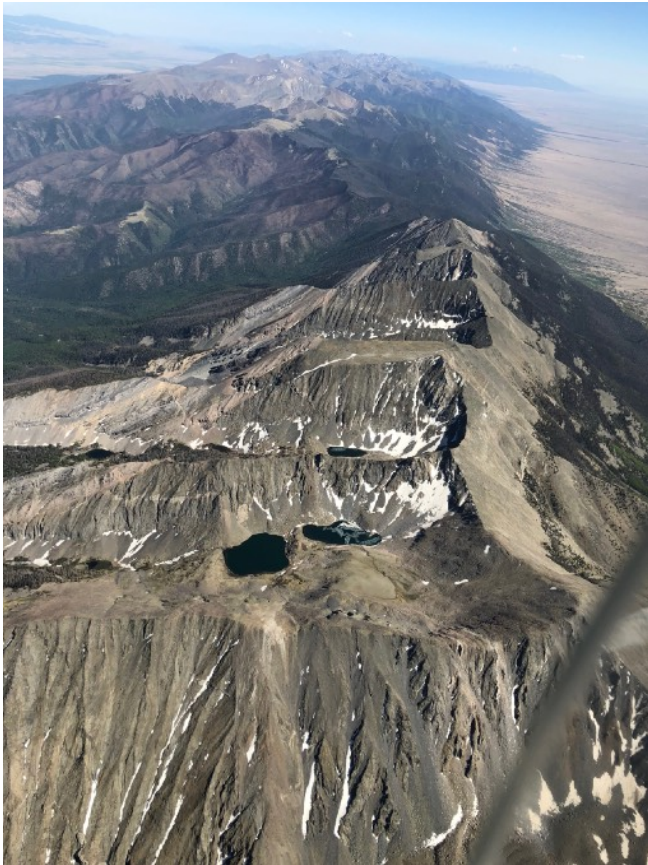

## EAA Chapter 80 Meeting Minutes May 2018

The chapter meeting was held on May 14th at Millard Airport, Oracle Aviation. The meeting was called to order at 7 PM by President Chris Halfman.

No guests or visitors were present.

Meeting Minutes: The April 2018 meeting minutes were approved as published.

Treasurer's Report: The May treasurer's report was approved as published. The report included receipts of \$366 for dues and the 50/50 drawing. Chapter expenses totaled \$6.48. Ending balance \$15,994.28. It was stated that there should be a discussion on what to do with excess funds.

Membership: Bob Condrey was absent, but it was reported that 31 members had still not paid their dues.

Tech Counselors: Mike Howard had nothing to report.

Young Eagles: The last two rallies have been cancelled due to weather. The next YE rally is planned for June 9th. The June rally will be done concurrently with the Millard Airport Fly-In Breakfast and Aviation Fair. Registration for young eagles can be done on line, with a limited registration of 60 youth. Those supporting the YE rallies can text EAA80YE to 84483 to get up to date texts when changes occur.

Tools: Jerry Ronk was absent, nothing to report.

1) Josh Tocko demonstrated a portable aircraft air conditioner he built from a cooler with various electrical parts purchased off EBay. Just a prototype, but considerably less expensive (so far) than those on the market.

2) Bill Haas, Berkut project, reports he is preparing for the builders meeting this month.
