Perfect operation up to the last start and then nothing but a click. Most lead acid batteries give you a warning by slow cranking of the engine but this does not seem to be true of the Odyssey battery. All the voltage and current numbers were perfectly normal up to the last start attempt then nothing. So if you have an Odyssey battery and it gets to be 4 or 5 years old, better replace or be stranded at Vermillion or?
